The Allen Endowment is pleased to announce the Florence Allen Scholarship Program for the 2024 – 2025 academic year. Ohio women (high school seniors and older) who are in need of financial aid to pursue an undergraduate degree or technical certificate are invited to apply.

2024 – 2025 scholarships will range from \$500 to \$1,000 and may only be used for that academic year at an accredited degree or certificate granting institution recognized by a state Board of Regents.

Traditional Students are eligible for Florence Allen Scholarships if they meet the following qualifications:

- 1. United States citizen and Ohio resident
- 2. A woman who will graduate or has graduated from an Ohio high school or has received a GED from the Ohio Board of Education prior to July 1, 2024
- 3. Pursing their first undergraduate degree or certificate

4. Undergraduates who meet the above criteria and are enrolled as full-time students at an accredited degree granting institution recognized by a state Board of Regents

**Non-Traditional Students** must be at least 30 years of age by April 1, 2024; meet all requirements of Traditional Students; and do not need to be a full-time student.

### INSTRUCTIONS TO FLORENCE ALLEN SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS

Eligibility for Florence Allen Scholarships is as follows:

Traditional Students are eligible for Florence Allen Scholarships if they meet the following qualifications:

- 1. United States citizen and Ohio resident
- 2. A woman who will graduate or has graduated from an Ohio high school or who has received a GED from the Ohio Board of Education prior to July 1, 2024
- 3. Pursing their first undergraduate degree or certificate
- 4. Undergraduates who meet the above criteria and are enrolled as full-time students at an accredited degree granting institution recognized by a state Board of Regents

**Non-Traditional Students** must be at least 30 years of age as of April 1, 2024. They must meet all of the requirements as Traditional Students but do not need to be attending school full time.

#### **IV. ESSAY QUESTIONS**

Respond to each of the following three questions on separate sheets of paper. Each response should not exceed one page, typed and single spaced.

#### 1. Career Objective and Counseling

Describe in specific terms your career goals, enrollment in the educational program, and a statement of financial need. Describe any career counseling you have received to analyze work in your chosen field and the availability of jobs in that field. This is your opportunity to present your case to the Scholarship Selection Committee for awarding you a scholarship. Spelling and grammar are important.

#### 2. School and Community Involvement

- a. Traditional Students: List your extracurricular activities school-related, community/church, volunteer, professional
- b. Non-Traditional Students: List any community/church, volunteer, and professional activities. Family responsibilities and other life experiences may be included as they may assist in the decision-making process.

#### 3. Honors and Awards

List any scholastic honors and awards you have received during your four years of high school and post high school. Recognition received during college/university/technical school should be included. Non-traditional students do not need to list high school honors.

## **V. LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION**

Three letters of recommendation from current and/or former teachers and professors, school officials, employers, or other persons who are not related to you.

These letters should highlight your past academic, employment and/or volunteer record; your ability to undertake and complete training; your outstanding strengths or characteristics; and any other information that would assist the Scholarship Selection Committee Selection process.

These letters must be submitted as part of your complete application.

# **VI. CONDITIONS AND TERMS OF AGREEMENT**

- 1. I understand that this application will be not considered for review unless all requested materials are submitted; the application is signed and dated; and postmarked on or before May 1, 2024.
- 2. I hereby acknowledge that all of the information included in this application packet is true and complete to the best of my knowledge.
- 3. I also understand that all applications will be held confidential, but no material will be returned. It will be destroyed.
- 4. Scholarship funds cannot be used for expenses incurred before the 2024 2025 academic year.
- 5. Payments will be made via check payable to both the student and the educational institution. Both must endorse the check.
- 6. Should I be awarded a scholarship, I agree to have my name used in publicity for the program.
- 7. Applicants are evaluated on documented financial need; precise description of career plans and goals; and academic, employment and volunteer record.
- 8. A majority of applicants who apply for a scholarship meet all eligibility criteria and are deserving of financial assistance. I understand that due to funding limitations not every eligible applicant will receive an award.
- 9. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
- 10. No later than May 31, 2024, scholarship recipients will be notified via letter signed by the President of The Allen Endowment.
- 11. All applicants will be notified via e-mail of all scholarship recipients.
